is Director of Instrumental Music at SDSMT. Previously, he served as professor of low brass and bands at the University of South Dakota and Rocky Mountain College, and in low brass and music theory at Del Mar College. He holds a Doctor of Musical Arts in Tuba Performance from Michigan State University, a Master of Music degree in Conducting from the University of New Mexico, and baccalaureate degrees in Music Education and Tuba Performance from the University of Akron. An active performer, Dr. Drobnak has performed as a guest artist/clinician with the South Dakota Brass Quintet, Michigan State University Wind Symphony, Billings Symphony Orchestra, Helena Symphony Orchestra, Lansing Symphony Orchestra, and Corpus Christi Symphony Brass Quintet and numerous band contests, solo & ensemble festivals and Octubafests. Tuba-Euphonium Press has published many of his brass arrangements.

## ***James D. Feiszli***

Director of Music Activities and Professor of Humanities, holds a Bachelor of Music Education degree from the University of Mount Union, a Master of Music degree in Music History from the University of Akron, and the Doctor of Musical Arts degree from Arizona State University. At SDSMT since 1983, he created and administers the music curriculum at SDSMT. Ensembles under Feiszli's direction have won awards and accolades in performances throughout the U.S and Europe. He is a member of the National Association of Teachers of Singing, the International Federation for Choral Music, the National Collegiate Choral Organization, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. He has been awarded the Meritorious Music Educator award by the South Dakota Music Educators Association and the Lifetime Achievement Award by the South Dakota ACDA. He is also the recipient of SDSMT's Presidential Award for Outstanding Professor and Virginia Simpson Award for Community Service.
